Low-Means Residents

Everyone entering into an aged care home for the first time from 01/07/2014 will need to be assessed by the Australian Government as Low-means and may be eligible to pay only an assessed Accommodation Contribution or receive the full government financial support.

If you have low income or no income other than the pension or low assets, you are totally welcome. We specifically maintain a minimum number of places for low-mean residents. The costs and payments are determined by government means testing.

- 1. Residents with low assets (at or below \$166,707.20) plus low income (below \$26,985.40)**
- 2. Residents with low income (at or below \$68,182.92) plus low assets (below \$49,000.00)**
- 3. Resident with very low assets (below \$49,000) plus very low income (below \$26,985.40)**
