Description of Services

Housekeeping/domestic assistance

Tasks can include dishwashing, errands, house cleaning, laundry, bill paying and unaccompanied shopping and meal preparation, either within a short term intensive timeframe, regular basis or as a once off.

Transport

Pennwood provides transport for customers and their carers (where required) to support access to their community i.e. medical appointments, social groups, exercise class, University of the 3rd Age etc. Transport can be provided with either a volunteer, care worker or a voucher.

Social Support

This may include companionship and activities based service i.e. shopping, movies etc.

Personal Care

To maintain independence in activities of daily living i.e. bathing, toileting, dressing, grooming, transfers in/out of bed and assistance with clients' self-administration of medication.

In-Home Respite Care

Through providing an appropriately trained in-home support worker, carers have an opportunity to pursue other activities, interests and take a well-earned break.

Home and garden maintenance

Gardening to help with safety and smoke alarm battery changes are also part of our service.

This includes work that complies within WHS and does not require specialised equipment or working at heights.

Clinical Care

We can provide a qualified nurse to attend to clinical assessments, after day surgery care, wound management, continence management, medication management (but not limited to this list)

Allied Health Professionals

Some of the services we can offer are Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Podiatry, Speech therapy, Dietician, Exercise Physiologist and Remedial Massage. We are however happy to assist you in accessing any other health professional that you may need.

(Clients can utilise the Health Care Assessment from their GP which entitles clients to 5 free sessions from an Allied Health professional)
