A basic daily care fee of up to 85% of the Australian single aged care pension will also be payable in addition to any accommodation payment or contribution. Definitions

Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD): A one off, upfront refundable lump-sum amount for accommodation.

Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP): A daily accommodation fee.

Combination Payment: Apportioned combination of the two above RAD and DAP payment options.

Government Supported Customer: A customer with assets less than \$51,500 at time of entry. A government supported customer is not required to pay a RAD or DAP.
