If your income and assets are over a certain amount you may be asked to make an accommodation payment that is agreed with Pennwood Village otherwise the Australian Government may pay for part or all of your accommodation costs ().

Definitions

Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD): A one off, upfront refundable lump-sum amount for accommodation.

Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP): A daily accommodation fee.

Combination Payment: Apportioned combination of the two above RAD and DAP payment options.

Government Supported Customer: A customer with minimal assets at time of entry. A government supported customer is not required to pay a RAD or DAP.
